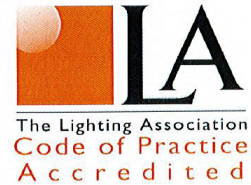

NOTE:

When a Member's 'Scope of Accreditation' includes either OPTION 1, OPTION 2 or OPTION 3 the following additional items will also be annually assessed:-

OPTION 1

100% electrical, mechanical and visual tests for purchased luminaries.

OPTION 2

Perform UK Batch testing to recognised AQL of all purchased luminaries.

Appointed personnel attend (once every 2 years) UK and or Far East Training Seminars which maintain their Authorisation to perform annual supplier Factory Audits and prepare Audit report for submission to LA for review.
(Alternatively: - Request LA to perform or arrange the annual supplier Factory Audits).

OPTION 3

Annual Pre-Delivery Inspection (PDI) review by LA Technical personnel at supplier factory premises where inspectors are assessed performing the complete PDI process.

Appointed personnel attend (once every 2 years) UK and or Far East Training Seminars which maintain their Authorisation to perform annual supplier Factory Audits and prepare Audit report for submission to LA for review.
(Alternatively: - Request LA to perform or arrange the annual supplier Factory Audits).
